Our Holy Prophet (SAW) emphasized the human rights of all people. Before Prophet Muhammad (SAW) there was no concept of universal human rights, it was he who gave the world this idea that all human beings have some God. Given and inalienable rights. He spoke about the right of life, right of basic necessities of life, right of property, protection of honour, Personal freedom of expression, freedom of conscience and conviction, equality before law, the right of consultation.

It was he who taught the dignity of workers and said that workers should be given fair wages and paid promptly. It was Prophet Muhammad (SAW) who taught the first time in history that rulers are responsible before their people and they can be removed by the people.

Holy Prophet Muhammad (SAW) was not only kind to muslims; he was also kind and respectful to non muslims. He gave them the message of islam, but never forced them to accept Islam. Some of his own relatives did not accept Islam but the Prophet did not mistreat them even

when he had full powers to do that He never allowed the starvation of any person even animals.

Dear friends!

We lag behind in supporting the humanitarian causes here in America and around the world. This is against the clear teachings and spirit of Islam. We should emphasize more and more humanitarian works; we should feed the poor people, provide clean water and clothes to them we should establish medical clinics for free treatment we should take care of orphans and widows we should establish educational institutions not only for muslims but also for others. Just as dawah is important humanitanan work is also very important Actually no successful dawah work can be done without sincere humanitarian work.
